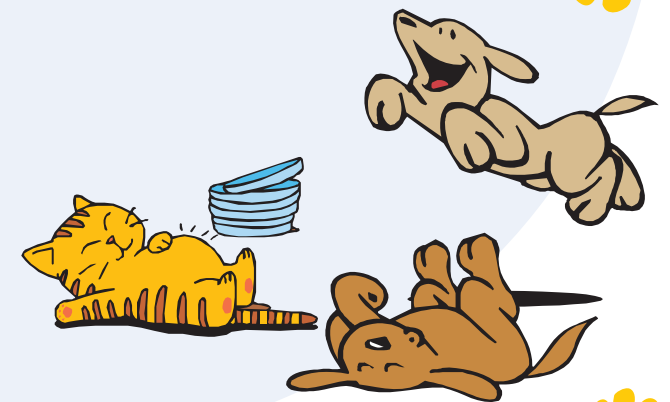

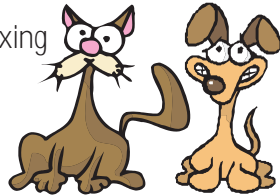

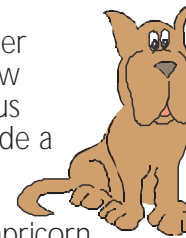
Our future focus is to aid in desexing the region's cats & dogs. This will help prevent unwanted litters suffering abandonment, cruelty and euthanasia.
